BERNINA FOUR CORNERS MAY 2009 CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Mondays

1. **Mastery class for 630E, 730E, and 830e Machines** - This is a 10-week, in-depth series of classes designed to help you learn all of the features of your new Artista/Series 8 machine, including directional stitching, embroidery, appliqué, buttonholes, and stitch recipes. Series began on March 23rd, from 10am to 2pm.

Space is limited—reservations are required.

Tuesdays

1. **“All Machines Mastery Intro”** is a three-hour class, offered twice a month, for new owners of Activa 210, 220, 230, & 240, as well as Aurora 430, 440, and 450 machines. New owners of 630E, 730E and 830E machines are welcome for very basic instruction of the use of their machine. Monday Mastery class is designed specifically for these machines. Students must bring their own machines. Included in the class is a project, which will familiarize students with their new machine, as well as instruction on how to clean and oil.

You may sign up for either May 12th or May 26th. ** Kit Fee: \$15 **

2. **“Beginning Quilting”** is a three-hour class, offered twice a month, for new students with little or no previous experience in basic quilting techniques. Want to learn to quilt? If you’ve never quilted before, this class is for you! Students may bring their own machine or use a classroom machine free of charge. **Space is limited; registration is required. Students must obtain a supply list and bring their own equipment to the first class.** Sign up, get your supply and be ready to begin a new adventure in creativity.

3. **“99 Ways to Use Your Sewing Machine”** – This class, which is already in progress, is offered through San Juan College. If you are interested in future classes, you may register by phone or on-line. Questions? Call 566-3214 for more details.

Wednesdays

1. **“Mastery Projects”—All Activa and Aurora Machines** is a month-long, three-hour, in-depth series of classes, designed to help you learn all of the features of your new Activa (210, 220, 230, or 240) or Aurora (430, 440, 450) machine. Students will learn how to use built-in function buttons, use of specialized feet, selection and proper stitch-out techniques of decorative stitches, and binding. Students must bring their own machines.

Project: Mini Wall Hanging – You will learn techniques for decorative stitches, pintucking and sewing beads on with your machine. You’ll be amazed at what you can do! **May 6, 13, 20 & 27, 9am to noon. Register at the store and pick up your supply list.**

2. **“It’s All About Me”—Embroidery Mastery Class** is a month-long, three-hour, in-depth series of classes, designed to help you learn to master the techniques of machine embroidery using your new Aurora 430, 440 QE, or 450 Anniversary Edition, specifically

designed for these machines but owners of other machines are welcome with permission from instructor. You will learn to use V5.0, EditorLite, Explorations and EConPC to transfer edited designs to your machine.

May 6th – You will learn what stabilizer is best for the project that you will be doing. Bring your notebook and take notes on stabilizers and hoops.

3. **“Youth Sewing”** will not be held during the month of May. The public schools are making up “snow days” from the winter. Youth sewing will resume in June & July, offered by San Juan College through the Kids’ College. Machines are provided, unless other arrangements are made. Projects are chosen which inspire the students to learn simple sewing techniques. Students must register through San Juan College and obtain supplies before coming to the first class.

Thursdays

1. **“Quilting with Sylvia”** is an on-going class for intermediate to advanced quilters. This intermediate class is for anybody who knows basic quilting and has a ¼ inch foot for their machine. The class project will be a wall hanging quilt by Eleanor Burns – **Radiant Star**. The supply list, which includes Eleanor’s book, is at the store. Sign up now! **Registration is required.** Students may borrow a class room machine, if needed. Students are responsible for bringing their own supplies and equipment.
